

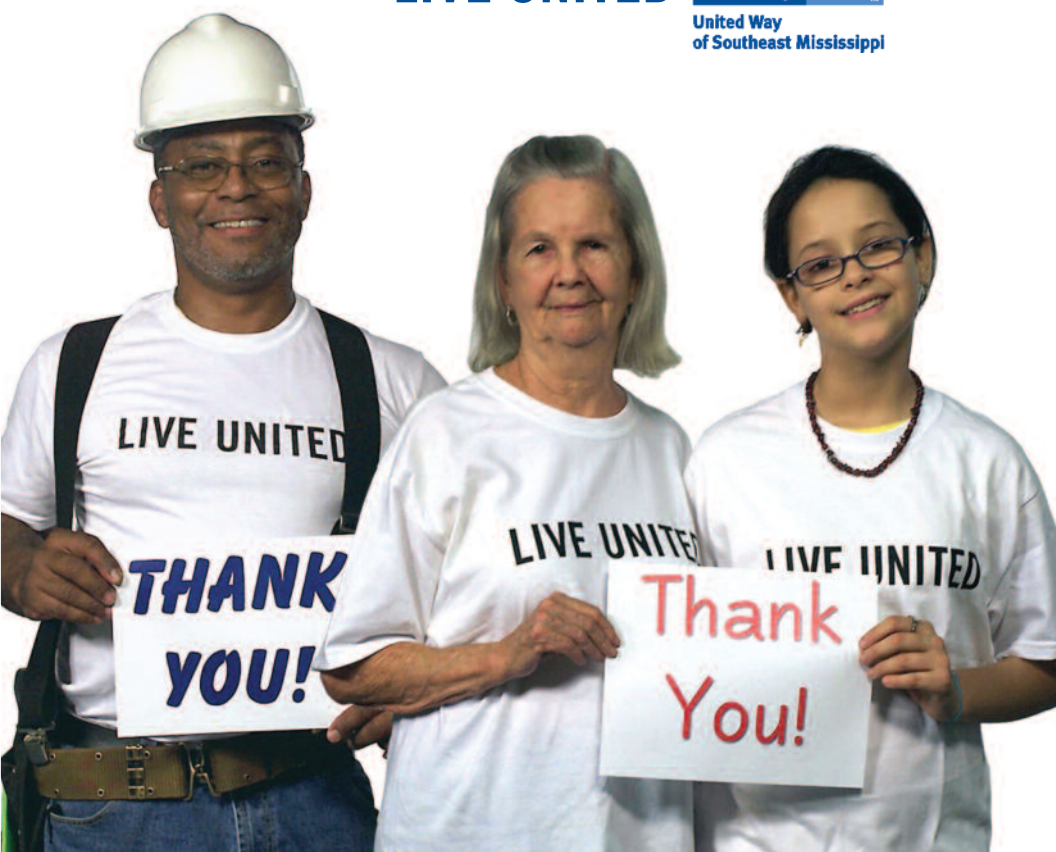

- *And many additional services were provided by these partners and others.*

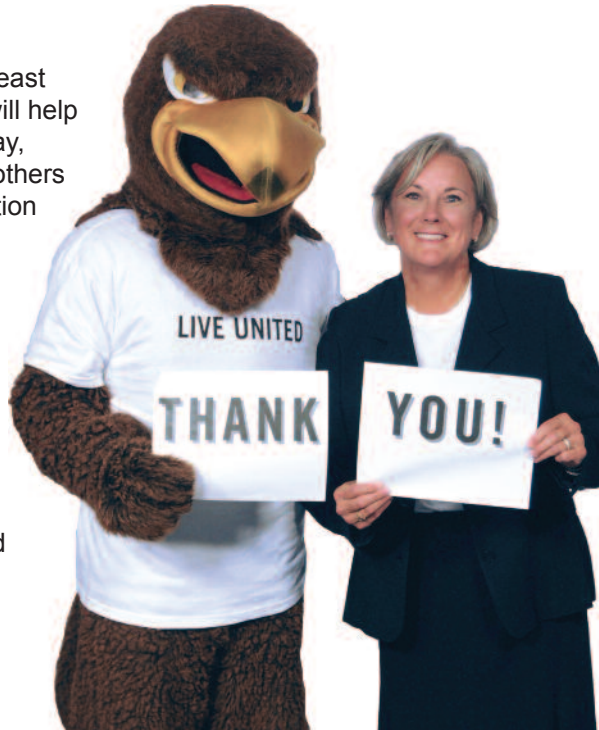

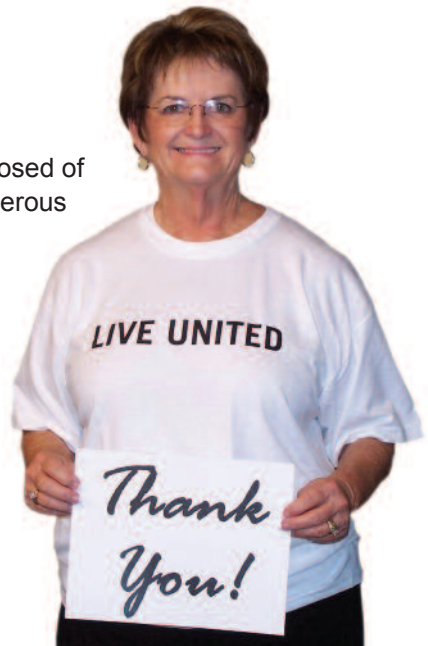
Planned Giving

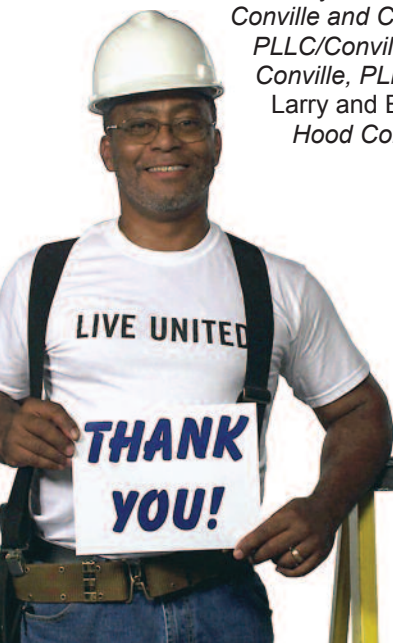
